

General Guidelines for conference paper submission

1. Language: UK English
2. Main author should be indicated otherwise the first author shall be presumed to be the main author.
3. For multiple authors, individual contribution to the conference paper should be indicated.
4. Submitted conference paper should be introduced with an abstract of 100-250 words with at most 5 key words.
5. Submitted conference paper should be typed, Times New Roman, 1.5 cm spaced, on single sides of A4 sheets; leaving a margin of 2.5cm on the right and left sides.
6. Submitted Conference paper should not exceed 8,000 words with tolerance of 5 percent.
7. There should be title page containing: - (i) Title of the conference paper (ii) Name of author(s) and his/her (their) designation (s)/title (s). (iii) Institution of origin (iv) Contacts of the authors .
8. Title: not more than 20 words.
9. Number of pages: Not more than 15 pages excluding references and preliminary pages.
10. Titles of tables, figures and other illustrations should be on the top; and source at the bottom.
11. Abbreviations should be spelt out or explained in the text when used for the first time
